ART	Grade 6 in Art
BIOLOGY	Grade 77 in Double Science or Grade 776 in Triple Science with a 7 in Biology Grade 6 in Maths is also required
BUSINESS STUDIES	Grade 6 in English (Literature or Language) and Grade 5 in Mathematics
CHEMISTRY	Grade 77 in Double Science or grade 776 in Triple Science with a 7 in Chemistry. Grade 6 in Maths is also required
COMPUTER SCIENCE	Grade 7 in Computing, or Grade 7 in Maths and either Grade 76 in Double Science or Grade 666 in Triple Science
ECONOMICS	Grade 7 or 6 in Maths and English (Literature or Language). Grade 7 can be in either Maths or English
ENGLISH LANGUAGE	Grade 6 in EITHER English Language or English Literature
ENGLISH LITERATURE	Grade 76 in English Language and English Literature (the 7 can be in either Language or Literature)
FRENCH	Grade 7 in French
FURTHER MATHS	Grade 9 in GCSE Mathematics
GEOGRAPHY	Grade 7 in Geography and Grade 6 in English (Literature or Language)
GERMAN	Grade 7 in German

To start an A Level programme of 3 A Levels you need to pass at least 8 or more GCSE passes at Grade 5, equivalent or better including Maths and English.

To start an A Level programme of 4 A Levels you need to pass at least 8 or more GCSE passes including Maths and English with an average GCSE grade score of 7.5 or better (equivalent to roughly half of your grades at half 7/A and half 8/A*).

You should choose one subject from each block in order of priority. Each subject has its' own entry requirements which will appear below the courses you select. In some subjects, students are set by ability and/or require a higher level of entry to ensure the right preparation for high level university courses.
