## Year 7 Catch Up Premium 2018-19

The Year 7 Catch Up Premium is funding provided by the Department for Education to help raise the attainment of students who meet the criteria for the Year 7 catch-up premium. This is to support student progress in English and Maths at the start of secondary education.

In 2017-18 William Perkin received £14,866.

In 2018-19 William Perkin received £14,000.

The funding is allocated to support:

- Literacy core elective lessons
- Numeracy core elective lessons

Last year the early intervention for literacy had a really effective impact on student achievement. The average rate of progress for a Year 7 student needing literacy intervention was 2 years 2 months.
